## **Report of the Tax Collector**

## As of December 31, 2023

- December deposits were \$5,036.56. Hebron total payments were \$1,213.27. Of that amount \$1,200.06 was for the current installment and interest was \$13.21. Lebanon payments were \$3,823.29, representing current tax payments of \$2,577.14, prior year payments of \$799.60, interest of \$350.55 and \$96.00 lien fees.
- Year to date payments were \$138,241.07.
  - O Hebron: \$60,046.68
  - O Lebanon: \$78,194.39.
  - Liz Bowen posted the legal notice of taxes coming due as required by law on the website.
  - A few escrow company payments for the January installment due were processed in December. The ability to view taxes due/ paid online continues to be very useful.
- Attorney Adam Cohen canceled the tax auction for the remaining delinquent properties which was to take place on Wednesday, January 10<sup>th</sup> at 10:am at the Lebanon Fire Safety Complex. One of the property owners paid in full to halt the sale. The other property had a faulty deed and had more than \$100,000 in back taxes due to the Town. We have the option of pursuing a tax sale at a later date. Information was updated at <u>www.cttaxsales.com</u>. All accounts that were turned over to Pullman and Comley for collection have been closed.
