# **Beaches and Rows Committee Meeting Minutes**

## Wednesday, August 14, 2024 @ 6pm – Francis ROW

**Call to order:** Meeting called to order at 6:05pm.

#### 1. Approval of previous meeting minutes:

Marge Nichols made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 10th meeting and Jodi Stubbings seconded. Minutes approved with two corrections: August meeting date is August 14, not August 9 as stated, and Karen Hinch's name was misspelled in the section on Cove ROW.

#### 2. Correspondence:

• Teri and Karen received an email from a resident interested in donating a bench at Main Beach dedicated to her parents, who owned property on Ames Rd for over 60 years. She now lives at the residence. Karen met with her on 8/13, and her preference was to install the bench near the volleyball net, where her grandchildren play volleyball and where she sat on a bench with her mother regularly. They can see this area from their home on Ames Rd. Also, the bench would be next to the one installed this spring for Moe Collin, who was a next-door neighbor and friend of the family. The Committee agreed to this location for the bench.

## 3. Reports from Stewards or Committee Members regarding Beaches and ROWs:

- Main Beach: Porta-potty was locked over the weekend, and guests thought it was unusable. It turns out the "occupied" sign can be locked and unlocked from the outside, and it was locked. It is easy to turn it from the outside, and Committee members were advised of this. Karen asked Frank Hoisl to inform beach pass checkers in case this happens again. Agreed we will have the porta-potties removed by the end of September, to avoid vandalism after the season has ended. We will install them on or around May 1<sup>st</sup> next year, and evaluate whether we need to have them locked up at night.
- Elsmere: Nothing to report
- Francis: Now that property has been surveyed, consider cleaning up landscaping in spring; possible A-frame boat rack for larger boats and bike rack. Question came up as to whether there is a limit on size of boats that can be stored on the ROWs. There is a 14-foot fishing boat leaning against the rocks at he shoreline and partially obstructing access to the water. This can be a consideration for the ordinance updates that are underway.
- **Oakland:** Geese no longer an issue. Discussion about golf carts; feeling of the committee is that golf carts should not be allowed on grassy parts of ROWs this will be considered for ordinance updates.
- **Meadowbrook:** Bushes on the left have been trimmed and look good. Odor from sewer pump has diminished. There is a paddleboat with no stickers on the ROW. Steward put a red warning sticker on it about a month ago, and it needs to be removed from the ROW. Karen to contact Frank Hoisl regarding removal.
- Cove: Stewards continue to clean out shoreline. Trimming of bushes near boat racks was completed. There are two boats with 2024 stickers (#265 and #1184) Karen to check on these and contact owners to get new stickers affixed.
- **Lollipop Beach:** Discussed weeds around docks at Lollipop. Advised hand-pulling of weeds is permitted after someone from Lake Health Committee inspects area to ensure no invasive weeds are present.

- **Ryan Terrace:** Need to move sand from the lake back to the beach area again Marge will pick a date and send out an email to get volunteers.
- Manion: Minor raking needed to get briars out of grass near shore (Karen will check it out).

## 4. Old Business:

• Only one bid was received by the July 31 deadline on the mowing and leaf cleanup at the beaches and ROWs. Once approved by the Board of Directors, the contractor will be contacted to sign a 3-year contract.
