Ordinance 2008.8(f)-Boats, in the Amston Lake District ordinances states in part, “...any boat which otherwise violates any rule or ordinance of the District, may be removed at the Board’s discretion at the owner’s expense...” and “...the District may dispose of the boat without further notice to the owner or liability to the District.” Section 2008.8(g) states in part, “...no person may moor, store...any boat which...otherwise adversely affects District waters or other residents,” and Section 2008.8(h) states in part, “No boat...may be stored or left unattended anywhere on District properties between November 1 and March 31 without special permission of the Board.” Due to the large number of boats left/stored on District properties in violation of our ordinances, the Board is including this language on this registration form as a reminder to all residents to kindly adhere to the ordinances so that the Board is not faced with the onerous task of removing boats in violation of our ordinances. Please be respectful of your neighbors and adhere to the Amston Lake District ordinances.
