To obtain this sticker, in addition to the description of your boat, you will also need to provide a copy of a CT DMV vessel registration (in your name) valid for the summer 2026 season or a copy of the vessel title (in your name).

Please Read and Sign

ALD Ordinance Section 2008.5 states, in part, “To gain access to ALD Properties or ALD Waters, the ALD property owners/residents must obtain and display current, valid Board-approved passes.” Section 2008.8 (g) states “Watercraft may only be stored in designated areas on/in ALD Properties or ALD Waters between April 1 and October 31.” Section 2008.8(h) states, in part, “...no person may moor, store, or operate on/in ALD Properties or ALD Waters any watercraft which...otherwise adversely affects District Waters or other residents/owners.” For any resident/owner who otherwise violates any rule or ordinance of the District, ALD Ordinance 2008.15 (a) states, in part, “The Board may enforce its Special Act, Bylaws, and Ordinances and protect the interests of the community by imposing fines, invalidating passes, towing vehicles or removing watercraft at the owner’s expense....” and Section 2008.15 (d) further states, in part, “....the District may dispose of the watercraft without further notice to the owner or liability to the District.” The Board has included this language on this registration form as a reminder to all residents/owners to kindly adhere to the ordinances so that the Board is not faced with the difficult task of imposing fines, invalidating passes, towing vehicles or removing boats in violation of our ordinances. Please be respectful of your neighbors and adhere to the Amston Lake District Ordinances which can be found at amstonlake.org.
