Meeting minutes

Meeting started at 6:32pm

-Introductions.

- Review/discussion of committee mission statement.
  - All attendees approved the mission statement and criteria for recommendations
- Additional dock details discussed/shared
  - 63 trailer boats stickers issued (31 non-lakefront)
  - The 2025 lottery had 3 “large boats” turned away as all spots were filled
  - There are only 7 slips out of 17 that can accommodate large boats (GT14.5 FT)
  - Currently docks are provided only for the current season (5-1 to 10-15).
  - Other lakes allow longer term usage and develop waitlists for owners unable to secure a slip initially.
  - The committee believes there is money in the 2025-2026 budget for benthic mats to dampen surface plant activity near the lollipop dock.
  - There is a “bubbler” installed at a dock near the Manion ROW. This is to keep the water unfrozen near the dock to minimize pilingshift and structure damage

  - Gather info about pricing of current dock system expansion at Lollipop based on a drawing provided Dave Arnold/Al Fichtel
