A. Call to Order

C. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (May 27, 2025)

D. GZA Yearly review meeting at the clubhouse 8/23

1. Frank wanted to remind everyone that on 8/23, starting 9:00am at the District Clubhouse GZA will present their yearly lake health review. It is a good time to interface one on one with GZA and to ask any questions the residents may have. If anyone on this committee has questions, they would like to present they can send them to me or Brandon, we can collect them and present them all at once but everyone is also welcome to ask questions individually. Barbara asked if we received answers to the questions we asked when GZA was on the lake over the summer during their aquatic plant life review. E. Benthic Mats

1. At the May Annual meeting the 2025-26 budget was approved so we have funding for benthic mats. Brandon to follow up at next board meeting to get status. Barbara has asked if the location/size of the mats has been finalized. The initial placement location will be around the rental docks at lollipop to help with accessibility to open water and a second location would be the lollipop beach area as identified by the Beaches and ROWs committee.

F. CAES (Agenda Addition)

1. Frank asked if a date has been identified for the CAES lake review. There was a plan by the Lake Health Committee to have them back on the lake in August to do an aquatic plant review. He further discussed that he coordinated members of the Board of Directors (BOD), Lake Health and the Lake Usage Committees to meet along the shore of Lollipop cove to review the cove situation. The Lake Usage Committee had provided a number of questions to Jeff Arpin (Lake Health Chair) to ask the CAES representative while they were on-site. No one had a specific date for the review. We should follow up with Jeff on status after their visit.
